





Our Commitments & Responsibilities

In order to have the greatest impact, Okanagan College has laid out aspirational goals across eight specific areas.

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- 1. Inclusive and equitable access: We will increase the participation and success rates of historically and currently marginalized learner populations by removing artificial, system barriers to post-secondary education.
- 2. Individualized lifelong learning: We will improve student success and engagement by making decisions that put the learner at the centre of everything we do, knowing there is no one-size-fits-all approach, and that learning happens at any age, from "K to grey."
- 3. Integration and focus: We will deliver programming that is aligned to current and future regional needs, building bridges between academic and instructional College portfolios so that students have opportunities to experience different perspectives, skills and ways of thinking.
